

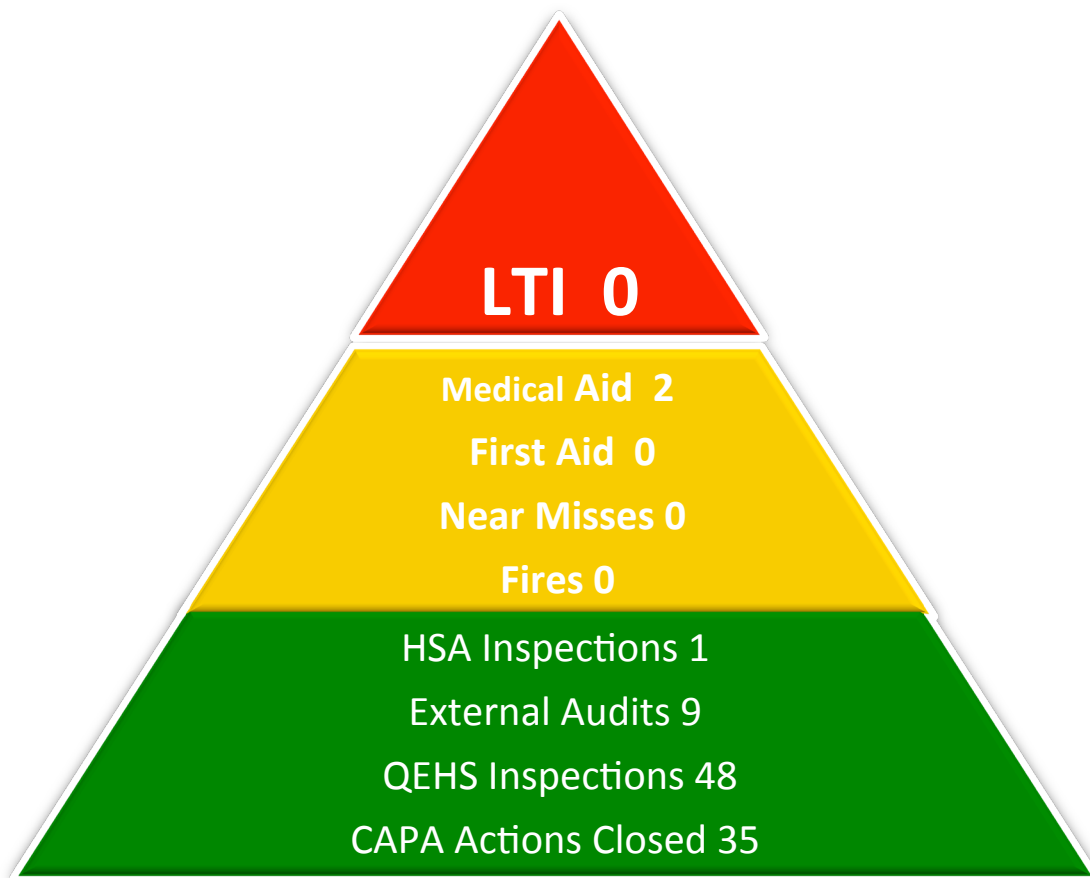
The Heinrich Safety Pyramid

Heinrich's Law is that in a workplace, for every accident that causes a major injury, there are 29 accidents that cause minor injuries and 300 accidents that cause no injuries. Because many accidents share common root causes, addressing more commonplace accidents that cause no injuries can prevent accidents that cause injuries.

PCL strive to ensure that the base of this triangle remains as broad as possible in order to reduce accidents and incidents that cause injury.

Abbreviations

LTI = Lost Time Incident – this is where a person missed a full working shift

Medical Aid = is more than first aid, where professional medical aid was required

QEHS Inspections = Quality, Environmental, Health & Safety Inspections
